CHILD PROTECTION POLICY STATEMENT

Bangor Golf Club is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for children and young people to practice golf.

We do this by:

- Recognising that all children have the right to freedom from abuse
- Ensuring that all of staff and volunteers are carefully selected and accept responsibility for helping to prevent the abuse of children in their care.
- Responding swiftly and appropriately to all suspicions or allegations of abuse and providing parents/carers and children with the opportunity to voice any concerns.
- Appointing a Child Welfare Officer who will take specific responsibility for child safety and act as a main point of contact for parents/carers, children and outside agencies.
- Ensuring access to confidential information is restricted to the Child Welfare Officer or the appropriate external authorities.
- Reviewing the effectiveness of our Child Protection Policy and activities each year at the Annual General Meeting.

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Section 8 - Terms and Conditions

General

Except where expressly agreed otherwise by us in writing every member of the club shall be subject to these Terms and Conditions. Bangor Golf Club reserves the right to exercise discretion in all matters relating to membership.

Contract Term

The subscription period and a member's contract with the club is for one year from 1st April to 31st March. For members who join during the year the subscription period and contract is from the date of joining to 31st March. **A member can only terminate or downgrade their membership at the end of the subscription year.** A member should advise the club of their intention before the 31st January of the year in question.

In exceptional circumstances (such as severe ill health but which is wholly within the discretion of the Council) members may be permitted to suspend or cancel their membership during the subscription year.

Payment of subscriptions

Subscriptions are due annually in advance ("the Due Date"). Payment will need to be made by Cash, Cheque, Bank Transfer, Credit or Debit Card.

Members wishing to pay by instalments may choose to enter into an agreement with such Finance House as authorised by the Club. Details can be obtained from the Office.

If a member wishes to avail of such an arrangement with a finance provider they may wish to consider taking out suitable and adequate insurance to cover the eventuality of being unable to play (or such other absence) during the Subscription Period.

Members should note that they are liable for the total subscription fee whether paying up front or by instalments.

Late payment

If neither a full subscription payment nor a commitment to membership via a Finance House (or some other acceptable arrangement) is received within 30 days of the Due Date, this will result in an administration fee of 10% of subscription fee being levied. If fees are not received within 60 days membership and all services and benefits will be suspended.

General

All categories of membership shall be subject to these terms and conditions of membership and to the rules, bylaws and regulations of the golf course which are in force at the time.

All Members agree to abide by the Rules of Golf and the requisite standard of conduct and etiquette. The Club rules and bye-laws are obtainable from the documents section of the club website.

Golf Cards are included in initial membership cost but replacement cards must be paid by the Member at time of request at a cost of £7.00.
